TRIO STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES



TRIO Student Support Services (TRIO SSS) is a federally funded program designed to help students stay in school, graduate with college degrees, and continue their education. The program assists students at the associate degree level and also offers a variety of transfer-related services to encourage students to transfer to a four-year institution.

To be eligible for TRIO Student Support Services, students must

- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours in an associate degree program
- Be a U.S. Citizen or eligible for federal student financial aid
- Be working on his or her first college degree AND



- Meet at least one of the following eligibility requirements:
 - Be a first-generation college student OR
 - Currently, live in an economically disadvantage household (TRIO will help you determine if you meet this criteria) OR
 - Have a documented disability verified by a licensed or certified professional

Assistance with Academic Needs

Study skills workshops, one-on-one academic counseling, and planning sessions are available to help develop your skills and plan for academic success.

Assistance with Career Goals

Assistance with Transfer Planning

Individualized transfer planning sessions, tours of nearby four-year colleges, and workshops about the college transfer process.

TRIO SSS provides cultural activities each year to help you increase your cultural awareness.

Financial/Economic Literacy Services

Workshops, referrals, a resource directory, connection to community providers, and computer-based instruction to help you increase your understanding for personal finance.

Peer Mentoring

Learn the ropes of being an SCC student from fellow successful TRIO SSS participants.

Personal Counseling

To assist you with personal, emotional, or social issues that may interfere with your ability to reach your full potential in college.

Tutoring

One-on-one and group tutoring are available.
