

SCC is seeking quotes for Twelve (12) Virtual Reality (VR) training headsets and training system technology to be used to support the college's current Corporate and Community Education (CCE) curriculum offerings. The purpose of the VR Units is to offer hands-on simulations and training for students to better understand the various career options, and experience virtually what it is like to work in selected fields of study. This request for quotes is for a twelve (12)-month term (one -year) and the cost should include all required equipment, system technology, training and support for the term.

The content needs to mirror the major focus areas of the SCC CCE programs to include the following areas:

- Industrial, Manufacturing & Trades
- Healthcare Training
- Construction

Manufacturing/Skilled Trades/Constructions

Careers in the Manufacturing cluster include occupations required to make products like vehicles, and household goods.

Pathways within this cluster include Manufacturing Production Process Development, Maintenance, Installation & Repair, Production, and Quality Assurance.

Careers in the Skilled Trades cluster include occupations using the knowledge and abilities of various trades, while also comprehending the usage of sketches, diagrams, and written instructions to implement said skills. Pathways within this cluster include Carpentry, Electricians, HVAC Workers, Metalworking, Machinists, Plumbers and Welders. Trainees will also build fundamental construction skills related to the building of structures, including buildings and homes, roads, and other infrastructure.

Healthcare

Careers in Healthcare cluster include occupations using knowledge to serve patients in CNA, Phlebotomy, Patient Care Tech and General Nursing.
