



SCC LIFE Scholarship Application for Early High School Graduates

Deadline date is the last day of the spring 2024 term: April 19, 2024

Students who complete all requirements for high school graduation prior to the official graduation date in May or June 2024 may be eligible to receive the LIFE Scholarship for the spring 2024 term if they meet all initial and general eligibility criteria. Required Documents:

To be considered for LIFE Scholarship as an Early High School Graduate, the following **must** be submitted to Spartanburg Community College by the deadline date:

1. Submit the following items to the SCC Admissions Center:
 - a. An official high school transcript in a sealed envelope. The transcript must include all grades through January 2024 and include a cumulative GPA based on the S.C. Uniform Grading Policy, and
 - b. A letter from your high school Principal/Guidance Counselor on the school's letterhead indicating you have **completed** all requirements for high school graduation.
2. Submit this completed *SCC LIFE Scholarship Application for Early High School Graduates* to SCC's Financial Aid Office.
3. All documents must be received by Spartanburg Community College no later than 5:00 pm on April 19, 2024.
4. **Incomplete documents and files as of the deadline date will not be considered.**
