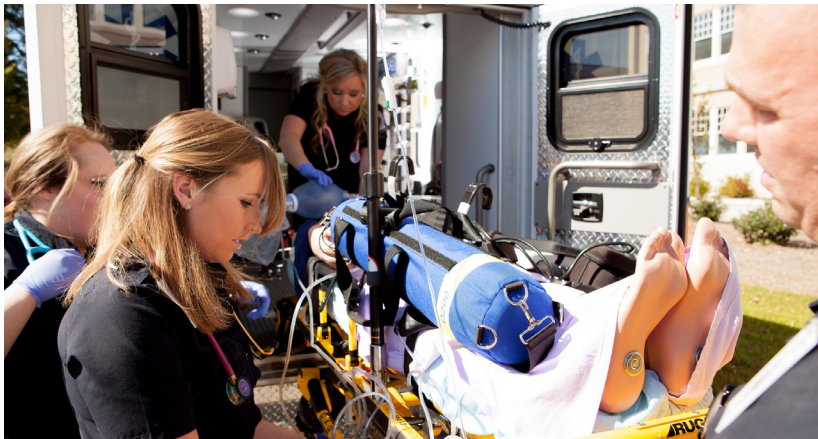


AIM Center



The AIM Center (Aspiration Inspiration Motivation) works to support academic success at SCC by helping to remove economic barriers that may hold students back from chasing their dreams.

To be Eligible for AIM, Students Must Identify with One of the Following Groups

- Student Disability Services
- Economically Disadvantaged Families (Including Low Income Youth And Adults)
- Non-Traditional Fields of Study
- Single Parents (Including Single Pregnant Women)
- English Learners
- Homeless Individuals
- In/Aged-Out Foster Care Services
- Students Whose Parents are in Active Duty Military



AIM Assistance Includes

- Childcare
- City Bus Tickets/ Transportation Support
- Educational Supplies, Laptop and Calculator Checkout
- Financial Assistance For Books
- Referral To Other Support Services (On and Off Campus)

How to Enroll

- Students must complete an online application each semester and be approved for continued service.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours (clinical do count).
- Attendance forms must be submitted each month.

Bookstore Assistance

- Courses must be program specific. Transitional (031-032) and general education courses are not eligible.
- Students are asked to return books at the end of the semester.

Childcare Assistance

- We pay a portion of your childcare bill four times per semester. You are responsible for any remaining balance to your childcare provider.
- Children must be enrolled in a certified daycare facility. SCC does not provide on-site childcare for your children.

Bus Passes

- 31-day passes are available. Students can receive up to four passes per semester.

**Please make sure your FAFSA is complete before applying.*

***Students enrolled in AS or AA (College Transfer) Programs are not eligible for assistance.*
