### Participant Academic Requirements

The AIM Center works to support your academic goals at Spartanburg Community College. There are several requirements that must be met prior to participating in and receiving services from the program.

**You must have a minimum GPA of 2.0.**

To those students who have a GPA that falls below the minimum requirement:

In order to continue participating in this program, you will be required to complete the next semester with grades that result in a cumulative 2.0 GOA or higher. To help you reach this requirement, The AIM Center will continue to support you throughout the first semester that your cumulative GPA is less than 2.0

These funds are generously provided through the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (Perkins V) mandates that the program maintain these GPA requirements for participation. As The AIM Center works towards this goal of academic achievement, our aim is to continue providing services that will support you in exceeding these standards and achieving your goal of graduation and employment.

**In addition to the GPA requirement, a student cannot be enrolled in the Transfer Program (AA or AS); cannot be enrolled in all Developmental/Transitional (031 & 032) classes; and you must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).**

**You must be enrolled in at least 6 hours. Of which, 3 hours must be on campus/ face-to-face.**

Continued assistance is contingent on funds availability and adherence to the above requirements and program policies.
