EARLY COLLEGE



EARLY COLLEGE provides eligible high school students who are 16 years of age or older the opportunity to enroll in SCC courses while still in high school.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Complete and submit the Early College Prospect and Application Form (required once upon initial application).

Complete and submit the Early College Permission and Registration Form (required annually—must be signed by student, parent/legal guardian, and high school or homeschool principal or designee.) Individual high school and career center requirements for determining approval for students to take classes may vary.

Complete and submit the Lottery Tuition Assistance FAFSA Waiver Form (required annually)

Take the COMPASS, ASSET, SAT, or ACT skills assessment to determine course eligibility and placement.

COURSE TRANSFERABILITY

Early College courses include university transfer, health sciences, and technologies courses. Course transferability requirements vary from college to college and by major. It is the student and his/her family's responsibility to determine the transferability of individual courses to colleges other than those in the South Carolina Technical College system.

Final course letter grades are recorded on the student's high school and SCC transcripts.

All SCC grades contribute to the student's satisfactory academic progress record and may impact future financial aid eligibility.
